Amittai: His name means <u>Truth</u>.

Ninevah: <u>Capital</u> of Assyria

1. God may ask you to do things you don't want to do. (1:2)

The Assyrians were Israel's worst <u>enemy</u>.

Delaying obedience is disobedience.

2. You can always find a boat sailing in the wrong direction. (1:3)

<u>Delayed</u> obedience can put you in a <u>dangerous</u> <u>position</u>.

- 3. God may send a storm to grab your attention. (1:4)
- 4. You worst nightmare might be exactly what you need. (1:7)
- 5. It is never too late to <u>cry out to God</u>. (2:1)

## The Gospel in Jonah:

- All men are sinful and deserving of judgment.
- Only sacrifice satisfies the wrath of God.
- Jonah foreshadows the <u>resurrection of Jesus</u>.
- Repentance and <u>faith</u> have always been God's requirement.
- All men have the <u>opportunity to believe</u>.
- 6. Don't <u>wallow in your mess</u>. Get up and follow God. (3:3)
